

SIXTH STREET PROSPECTIVE INVESTOR PRIVACY NOTICE

Our Commitment to Your Privacy

This Privacy Notice applies to the information that Sixth Street may collect from (i) investors and prospective investors who are natural persons and (ii) representatives of corporate investors and prospective investors who are resident in the EEA or UK (together, “EEA Investors”) who register to attend Sixth Street investor meetings, conferences or events.

Information We Collect

In connection with your registration for the meeting, conference or event, we will collect your legal name, preferred name, email address, telephone number, dietary restrictions, credit card information, travel preferences, employer and assistant information and other special requests/accommodations. Please do not provide personal information that you do not want us to have.

How We Use the Information We Collect

When you provide information to us for registration purposes, the information is used to register you to attend the event. In addition, we will use the information to send you relevant marketing/fundraising-related materials about Sixth Street affiliated investment funds, event invitations, agendas, newsletters and other related materials.

How We Share the Information We Collect

We may share your personal information with affiliates of Sixth Street Partners, LLC for the purposes described in this Notice.

We may share personal information with service providers that perform services on our behalf, such as event management vendors, and hosting, accommodation and travel providers.

In addition, we may disclose personal information about you (a) if we are required or permitted to do so by law or legal process, for example due to a court order or a request from a law enforcement agency, (b) when we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to prevent physical harm or financial loss, (c) in connection with an investigation of suspected or actual fraudulent or other illegal activity, or (d) in connection with (i) the making, management or disposition of any of our investments or (ii) business continuity.

Data Transfers

If you are located in the European Economic Area (“EEA”) or the UK, we comply with applicable legal requirements providing adequate protection for the transfer of personal information to recipients in countries outside of the EEA, UK and Switzerland. In all such cases, we will only transfer your personal information if:

- The country to which the personal information will be transferred has been granted a European Commission adequacy decision; or
- We have put in place appropriate safeguards in respect of the transfer, for example the EU Model Contracts.

You may request a copy of the safeguards that we have put in place in respect of transfers of personal data by contacting us as described in the “How to Contact Us About Privacy Matters” section below.

Information Security

We maintain appropriate technical and organisational measures designed to protect your personal information against loss or accidental, unlawful or unauthorised, alteration, access, disclosure or use. Unfortunately, no data transmission or storage system can be guaranteed 100% secure. If you have reason to believe that your interaction with us is no longer secure, please notify us immediately.

How long we keep information

The time period for which we keep personal information depends on the purposes for which we collected it. In all cases we keep it for as long as necessary to fulfil those purposes. We will then delete this personal information unless we are required to preserve your personal data in connection with litigation, investigations and proceedings, or if a longer retention period is required or permitted by applicable law.

Information for EU and UK Residents

Sixth Street Europe LLP is the data controller in respect of personal information collected in connection with your registration.

We process your personal information for the purposes described above on the basis that it is necessary for our legitimate interests in administering Sixth Street conferences and events. We may use your personal information to send direct marketing only where you have provided your consent or otherwise when we are permitted by applicable law to do so.

If you are located in the EEA, UK or Switzerland, subject to applicable law, you may have the following rights in relation to personal information that we hold about you:

- To request confirmation of whether we process personal information relating to you and, if so, to request a copy of that personal information;
- To request that we rectify or update your personal information that is inaccurate, incomplete or outdated;

- To request that we erase your personal information in certain circumstances, such as where we collected personal information on the basis of your consent and you withdraw your consent;
- To request that we restrict the use of your personal information in certain circumstances, such as while we consider another request that you have submitted, for example a request that we update your personal information;
- Where you have given us consent to process your personal information, to withdraw your consent; and
- To request that we provide a copy of your personal information to you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format in certain circumstances.
- To object to certain of our data processing, such as for direct marketing purposes.

If you are located in the EEA and you wish to exercise any of your data protection rights or if you consider that we have processed your personal information in violation of applicable law, please contact us as detailed in the "How to Contact Us About Privacy Matters" section below. If you consider that we have processed your personal information in violation of applicable law and failed to remedy such violation to your reasonable satisfaction, you may also lodge a complaint with the data protection supervisory authority in your country.
