
President's Dinner

Beethoven

Step back in time in Bonn, Germany, with a visit to the Beethoven-Haus — the only surviving residence of Ludwig van Beethoven's family. This remarkable museum spans twelve thoughtfully curated rooms that trace the composer's life, from his early years to his influential career and enduring legacy. Offering an intimate glimpse into his world, the museum showcases original manuscripts, personal belongings, and historic instruments. Interactive exhibits further enrich the experience, making it a must-see for music lovers and history enthusiasts alike.







UNESCO World Heritage Site

A visit to Kinderdijk offers a fascinating glimpse into the Netherlands' iconic water management system. Home to 19 well-preserved 18th-century windmills, this UNESCO World Heritage Site allows you to get up close to these historic structures and explore their remarkable engineering. Step inside two museum windmills to discover the daily lives of the millers and gain insight into how these ingenious machines helped shape the Dutch landscape.





Passport/VISA info: Canadians travelling to Germany/Netherlands will require a minimum of 6 months validity on their passport.

Currency: Euro is the preferred method of payment. Most places will accept credit/debit cards. ATMs are commonly found throughout the country.

Official Languages: German and Dutch

Water: It is safe to drink the tap water anywhere in Germany or the Netherlands

Electric Current: 230V at 50 Hz. A Type C or Type F travel adapter is required to use Canadian plugs in Dutch outlets, and Type F travel adapter for Germany.

Time Zone: Traveling in April/May, Germany and the Netherlands will be observing daylight savings. At this time, Germany and the Netherlands will be in Central European Summer Time (UTC+2).

Seasons

Spring: Temperatures approximately 10-17°C from March - May

Summer: Temperatures approximately 20-22°C from June - August

Autumn: Temperatures approximately 5-18°C from September - November

Winter: Temperatures approximately 2-7°C from December - February
